Summary Proceedings

The Fortieth meeting of the National Center for Injury Prevention and Control (NCIPC; Injury Center) Board of Scientific Counselors (BSC) was convened on Tuesday, July 26, 2022 via teleconference and Zoom. The BSC met in closed session in accordance with the Privacy Act and the Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA). Dr. Amy Bonomi served as Chair.

This meeting was closed to the public in accordance with the determination that it was concerned with matters exempt from mandatory disclosure under Sections 552b(c)(4) and 552b(c)(6), title 5, U.S. Code and Section 10(d) of the Federal Advisory committee Act, as amended (5 U.S.C. Appendix 2). The Scientific Review Officer explained policies and procedures regarding avoidance of conflict of interest situations; voting and priority rating; and confidentiality of application materials, committee discussions, and recommendations. Committee members absented themselves from the meeting during discussion of, and voting on, applications from their own institutions, or other applications in which there was a potential conflict of interest, real or apparent.

Upon establishing a quorum, a secondary review was conducted for the following NCIPC Notice of Funding Opportunity Announcements (NOFOs)

1. **RFA-CE-22-003:** Rigorously Evaluating Programs and Policies to Prevent Child Sexual Abuse (CSA) Impacting Children and Youth. The SEP to conduct primary peer review of the applications to this NOFO was convened as a virtual meeting via Zoom on April 19, 2022.
2. **RFA-CE-22-005:** Research Grants to Prevent Violence and Violence Related Injuries. The SEP to conduct primary peer review of the applications to this NOFO was convened as a virtual meeting via Zoom on May 10, 2022.

3. **RFA-CE-22-006:** Research Grants to Evaluate the Effectiveness of Physical Therapy-Based Exercises and Movements Used to Reduce Older Adult Falls. The SEP to conduct primary peer review of the applications to this NOFO was convened as a virtual meeting via Zoom on May 17, 2022.
4. **RFA-CE-22-007:** Reduce Health Disparities and Improve Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) Implementation of CDC's Pediatric Mild TBI Guideline. The SEP to conduct primary peer review of the applications to this NOFO was convened as a virtual meeting via Zoom on June 5, 2022.
5. **RFA-CE-22-008:** Using Data Linkage to Understand Suicide Attempts, Self-Harm and Unintentional Drowning Deaths Reduce Older Adult Falls. The SEP to conduct primary peer review of the applications to this NOFO was convened as a virtual meeting via Zoom on May 17, 2022, 2022.
